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Hanford Summary

Workforce/Economics

- 9,305 total DOE and contractor employees
- Hanford Budget is approximately \$2.3 billion per year
- Continued need for cleanup at current funding levels for the foreseeable future
- Cleanup mission continues to 2050 - 2060
- Richland Operations Office and the Office River Protection reported **\$51M** of small business awards in fiscal year 2016
- Outlook for fiscal years 2017 – 2018 small business awards will be similar

Office of River Protection Prime Contractors

Office of River Protection (ORP)

ORP is responsible for planning, integrating, and managing the River Protection Program executed by contractors performing work under ORP overall management.

Washington River Protection Solutions (WRPS)

WRPS is the prime contractor responsible for safely managing and operating the Tank Farms.

Bechtel National, Inc. (BNI)

BNI is responsible for the engineering and construction of the Waste Treatment Plant.

Wastren Advantage, Inc. (WAI)

WAI is the prime contractor responsible for managing the 222-S Laboratory.





Richland Operations Office Prime Contractors

RL is responsible for environmental cleanup including restoring the Columbia River Corridor, transitioning the Central Plateau of the Hanford Site for waste treatment and long-term storage, and putting DOE's assets to work solving regional and global environmental problems.

CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company (CHPRC)

- responsible for the safe, environmental cleanup of the Central Plateau at the Hanford Site.

HPM Corporation (HPMC)

- responsible for the occupational medical services to DOE and Hanford Site employees.

Mission Support Alliance (MSA)

- responsible for the integrated infrastructure services at the Hanford Site.





Near-Term Opportunities With DOE at Hanford

- **ORP Tank Waste Management contract(s) Post FY 2018**
 - ORP had 12 SBs respond to Industry Day
 - RFI issued March 2016
- **RL Acquisitions Post FY 2018**
 - RL had 30 SBs respond to Industry Day
 - Sources Sought Noticed issued Oct. 2015
- **Other RL Upcoming Acquisition**
 - Hanford Advisory Board (HAB) Facilitation Services, anticipate to be advertised via FedConnect October/November 2016
 - General Service Support, anticipate to be advertised via GSA eBuy late FY17/early FY18 for various scopes of work ranging from project management to operational and consulting support.
